In the 1950s and 1960s, Andre Simon, the famous food and wine writer, was a regular. So were Lord Miles, the founder of the Mermaid Theatre and father of Sarah Miles; Sir Malcolm Sargent, the conductor; Tony Hancock, the comedian; Leon Goossens, oboist; and Dorothy Tutin and Dame Edith Evans, neither of whom need any introduction to theatre buffs.

The iconic Rolling Stones album, Beggars Banquet was launched in our very own Bar 190 in 1968 with scenes from that historic party adorning the walls.

Before that, members of aristocracy from all over Europe enjoyed the Gore's bang-up-todate facilities, particularly our hydraulic elevator and horse carriage service.
